Having imported from both its Left and Right Banks for over four decades, we have established access to a network of producers whose wines continue to add breadth and value to our customers' wine lists.

This means authentic red wines from across the easily recognised appellations, from Bordeaux AOC to Saint-Emilion, Pauillac, Pomerol and Haut-Médoc which can include more curious points of interest for the well-versed drinker such as Fronsac or Cadillac. Whether your customers are inclined toward a plush, merlot-dominant blend or more structured, cabernet sauvignon-based cuvées, they'll find the right claret on your list.

Where crisp and dry or sweet and unctuous white wines are appropriate, Bordeaux's grand tradition in sauvignon blanc/sémillon blending has much to offer. Here, the Entre-Deux-Mers and Bordeaux Blanc appellations are perfect for those who like sleek fruit and heightened minerality in their whites, or the wines of Sauternes for those opting for a richer, honeyed fruit profile to enjoy with dessert dishes or on its own. 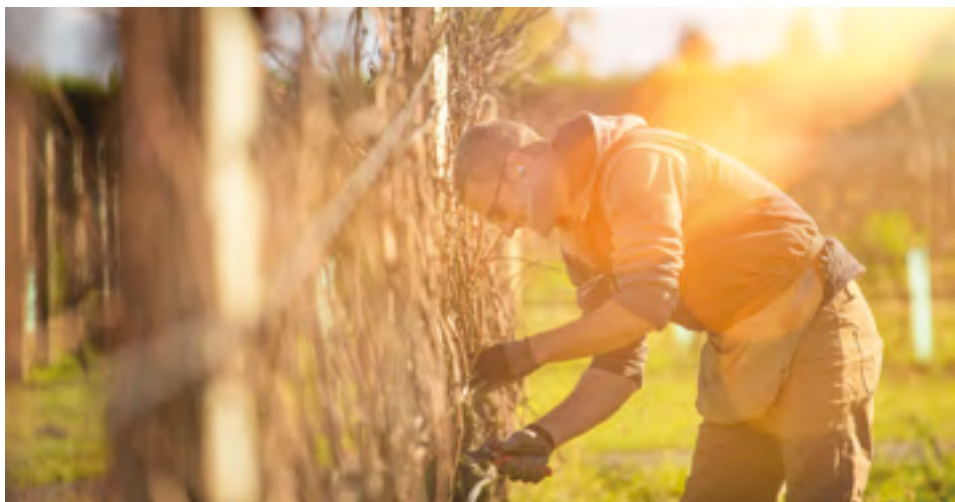
